Christine's work explores visual impairment after stroke, aiming to improve assessment and management of visual problems, especially visual field loss. She is lead and co-author on a number of Cochrane systematic reviews of intervention effectiveness, and uses a mixed-methods approach to her primary research work. Currently funded by the Stroke Association, she works extensively with stroke and vision clinicians, working to bridge the gap between services, and enable better care for stroke survivor with visual impairment.
